Tam discussed "Kearny pilot". Kearny has been taking Premium as well during pilot. Private rooms necessary – need to work out details. Kearny will be getting matches through Internet without Premium Sports. Celtic will be working to provide legal protection for Federation and individual clubs. There are questions about US and Canadian differences (legal regarding private clubs). In future Federation may "show appreciation for Kearny's efforts (and sunk legal costs). Premium will still have commercial rights and will aggressively market it in area. This will affect local Clubs not involved in pilot.
